QUALIFY FOR A \$300 TAX CREDIT

Absolute Steel Hybrid Woodstove- Model 211
Ideal Steel Hybrid Woodstove- Model 210
Progress Hybrid Woodstove- Model 209
Fireview Woodstove - Model 205
Keystone Woodstove -Model 204
Palladian Woodstove -Model 202

The wood stoves listed above each have a thermal efficiency greater than 75% and satisfy the IRS requirements to be considered "qualified energy property" under Section 25C of the Internal Revenue Code. These stoves qualify for a tax credit for their purchase and installation costs under the energy tax credit package signed into law on February 9, 2018.

The amount of the tax credit for a qualifying biomass stove is \$300. Consumers must keep a copy of this certificate with their tax records but do not need to submit it to the IRS with their tax returns.

The following restrictions apply:

- *Eligible stoves must be purchased and placed into service in an existing primary residence between January 1, 2017 and December 31, 2017.*
- *The current tax credit can be applied to the purchase price and professional installation costs up to a maximum credit of \$300.*
- *Homeowners who have taken advantage of previous energy tax credits may not be eligible for the current tax credit. There is a maximum "lifetime" energy tax credit cap of \$500, retroactive to 2006. If a homeowner has used \$500 or more in previous energy tax credits, he/she may no longer be eligible for the \$300 credit currently offered.*
